MARKET SUMMARIES FOR JUNE

Pacific Northwest (FO 124)


Producers delivered a total of 761.5 million pounds of milk to the market during June. Daily deliveries averaged 25.4 million pounds, down 0.02 percent from May. An estimated 488 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 52,017 pounds, down 0.02 percent from May.

Class I producer milk during June totaled 126.8 million pounds, 16.7 percent of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 4.2 million pounds, down 12.1 percent from May.

Arizona (FO 131)

Producers delivered a total of 414.0 million pounds of milk to the market during June. Daily deliveries averaged 13.8 million pounds, down 1.5 percent from May. An estimated 80 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 172,493 pounds, down 10.1 percent from May.

Class I producer milk during June totaled 91.4 million pounds, 22.1 percent of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 3.0 million pounds, down 8.8 percent from May.

CURRENT COMMODITY PRICES

The AMS survey of cheddar cheese prices showed an increase in prices received for 40-pound blocks and for 500-pound barrels. The survey of 40-pound blocks showed an increase of 11.89 cents between the June 15 and the July 13 surveys, to \$1.8453 per pound. The survey of 500-pound barrels (adjusted to 38% moisture) showed an increase of 18.52 cents to \$1.7703 per pound.

The AMS butter price showed a net increase of 1.39 cents between the weeks ending June 15 and July 13 from \$2.3805 per pound to \$2.3944 per pound. The AMS nonfat dry milk showed a net increase of 0.6 cents since mid-June to \$1.0510 per pound. The average price for AMS whey showed a net increase of 0.07 cents since mid-June to \$0.3676 per pound.




