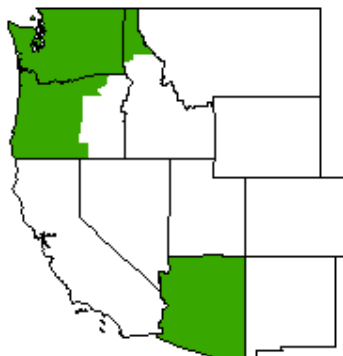

MARKET SUMMARIES FOR DECEMBER 2011

Comparisons to a year ago can be found in the tables on pages 6 and 7.

Pacific Northwest

Producers delivered a total of 581.0 million pounds of milk to the market during December. Daily deliveries averaged 18.7 million pounds, down 14.9 percent from November. An estimated 513 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 36,535 pounds, up 3.7 percent from November.

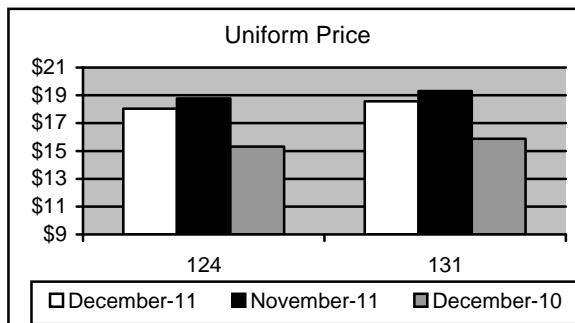
Class I producer milk during December totaled 190.6 million pounds, 32.8 percent of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 6.1 million pounds, down 4.2 percent from November.

Arizona

Producers delivered a total of 386.1 million pounds of milk to the market during December. Daily deliveries averaged

12.5 million pounds, up 3.8 percent from November. An estimated 98 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 127,081 pounds, up 3.8 percent from November.

Class I producer milk during December totaled 118.8 million pounds, 30.8 percent of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 3.8 million pounds, down 5.6 percent from November. ♦
