Attached is a list of plants regulated by Federal Orders 124, 131 and 135. Certain other plants having a prior record of association with the respective markets and cooperative associations representing producers on each market are also shown. Please use this list to report properly the movement of fluid milk products between your plant(s) and other plants. Classification of transfers and diversions will be determined pursuant to the provisions of the respective orders.

Plants regulated in the Pacific Northwest market are listed beginning on page 1 with similar listings for the Arizona-Las Vegas and Western Orders. For your convenience the list has been divided into sections for each market as follows:
