

MILK MARKET SUMMARIES FOR FEBRUARY 2000

James R. Daugherty, market administrator for the Pacific Northwest (FO 124), Western (FO 135), and Arizona-Las Vegas (FO 131) Federal milk orders, reports the following market information for the month of February 2000.

Pacific Northwest

Producers delivered a total of 549.5 million pounds of milk to the market during February. Daily deliveries averaged 18.9 million pounds, up 1.1 percent from January. An estimated 1,080 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 17,544 pounds.

Class I producer milk during February totaled 169.4 million pounds, 30.8% of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 5.8 million pounds, up 4.3 percent from January.

Western

Producers delivered a total of 302.6 million pounds of milk to the market during February. Daily deliveries averaged 10.4 million pounds, up 0.3 percent from January. An estimated 701 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 14,883 pounds down 0.2 percent from January.

Class I producer milk during February totaled 83.6 million pounds, 27.6% of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 2.9 million pounds, up 6.4 percent from January.

Arizona-Las Vegas

Producers delivered a total of 271.9 million pounds of milk to the market during February. Daily deliveries averaged 9.4 million pounds, up 8.0 percent from January. An estimated 117 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 80,141 pounds, .

Class I producer milk during February totaled 81.3 million pounds, 29.9% of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 2.8 million pounds, up 10.0 percent from January.
