

MILK MARKET SUMMARIES FOR JULY 2000

James R. Daugherty, market administrator for the Pacific Northwest (FO 124), Western (FO 135), and Arizona-Las Vegas (FO 131) Federal milk orders, reports the following market information for the month of July 2000.

Pacific Northwest

Producers delivered a total of 614.0 million pounds of milk to the market during July. Daily deliveries averaged 19.8 million pounds, up 23.9 percent from June. An estimated 1,058 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 18,722 pounds, up 0.0 percent from June.

Class I producer milk during July totaled 162.1 million pounds, 26.4% of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 5.2 million pounds, down 6.5 percent from June.

Western

Producers delivered a total of 392.9 million pounds of milk to the market during July. Daily deliveries averaged 12.7 million pounds, down 0.5 percent from June. An estimated 760 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 18,005 pounds, up 0.5 percent from June.

Class I producer milk during July totaled 79.0 million pounds, 20.1% of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 2.5 million pounds, down 6.7 percent from June.

Arizona-Las Vegas

Producers delivered a total of 251.7 million pounds of milk to the market during July. Daily deliveries averaged 8.1 million pounds, down 6.7 percent from June. An estimated 129 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 62,950 pounds, down 13.9 percent from June.

Class I producer milk during July totaled 73.1 million pounds, 29.0% of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 2.4 million pounds, down 8.0 percent from June.
