

## MILK MARKET SUMMARIES FOR JULY 2001

James R. Daugherty, market administrator for the Pacific Northwest (FO 124), Western (FO 135), and Arizona-Las Vegas (FO 131) Federal milk orders, reports the following market information for the month of July 2001.

### Pacific Northwest

Producers delivered a total of 644.0 million pounds of milk to the market during July. Daily deliveries averaged 20.7 million pounds, up 0.1 percent from June. An estimated 1,257 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 16,526 pounds, up 0.2 percent from June.

Class I producer milk during July totaled 168.5 million pounds, 26.2% of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 5.4 million pounds, down 1.6 percent from June.

### Western

Producers delivered a total of 447.4 million pounds of milk to the market during July. Daily deliveries averaged 14.4 million pounds, down 5.8 percent from June. An estimated 764 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 18,889 pounds, up 1.9 percent from June.

Class I producer milk during July totaled 83.8 million pounds, 18.7% of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 2.7 million pounds, up 1.8 percent from June.

### Arizona-Las Vegas

Producers delivered a total of 232.2 million pounds of milk to the market during July. Daily deliveries averaged 7.5 million pounds, down 10.3 percent from June. An estimated 114 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 65,718 pounds, down 10.3 percent from June.

Class I producer milk during July totaled 73.1 million pounds, 31.5% of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 2.4 million pounds, down 2.8 percent from June.
