

MILK MARKET SUMMARIES FOR NOVEMBER 2001

James R. Daugherty, market administrator for the Pacific Northwest (FO 124), Western (FO 135), and Arizona-Las Vegas (FO 131) Federal milk orders, reports the following market information for the month of November 2001.

Pacific Northwest

Producers delivered a total of 600.6 million pounds of milk to the market during November. Daily deliveries averaged 20.0 million pounds, up 9.8 percent from October. An estimated 1,224 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 16,356 pounds, down 14.9 percent from October.

Class I producer milk during November totaled 184.1 million pounds, 30.7% of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 6.1 million pounds, up 0.7 percent from October.

Western

Producers delivered a total of 453.4 million pounds of milk to the market during November. Daily deliveries averaged 15.1 million pounds, up 58.1 percent from October. An estimated 826 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 18,297 pounds, up 58.1 percent from October.

Class I producer milk during November totaled 91.3 million pounds, 20.1% of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 3.0 million pounds, up 2.1 percent from October.

Arizona-Las Vegas

Producers delivered a total of 232.7 million pounds of milk to the market during November. Daily deliveries averaged 7.8 million pounds, up 0.9 percent from October. An estimated 114 producers delivered milk to the market during the month. Daily deliveries per producer averaged 68,053 pounds, up 0.9 percent from October.

Class I producer milk during November totaled 81.6 million pounds, 35.1% of total producer receipts. Daily usage averaged 2.7 million pounds, up 1.4 percent from October.
