Chart 1 - Class III Price

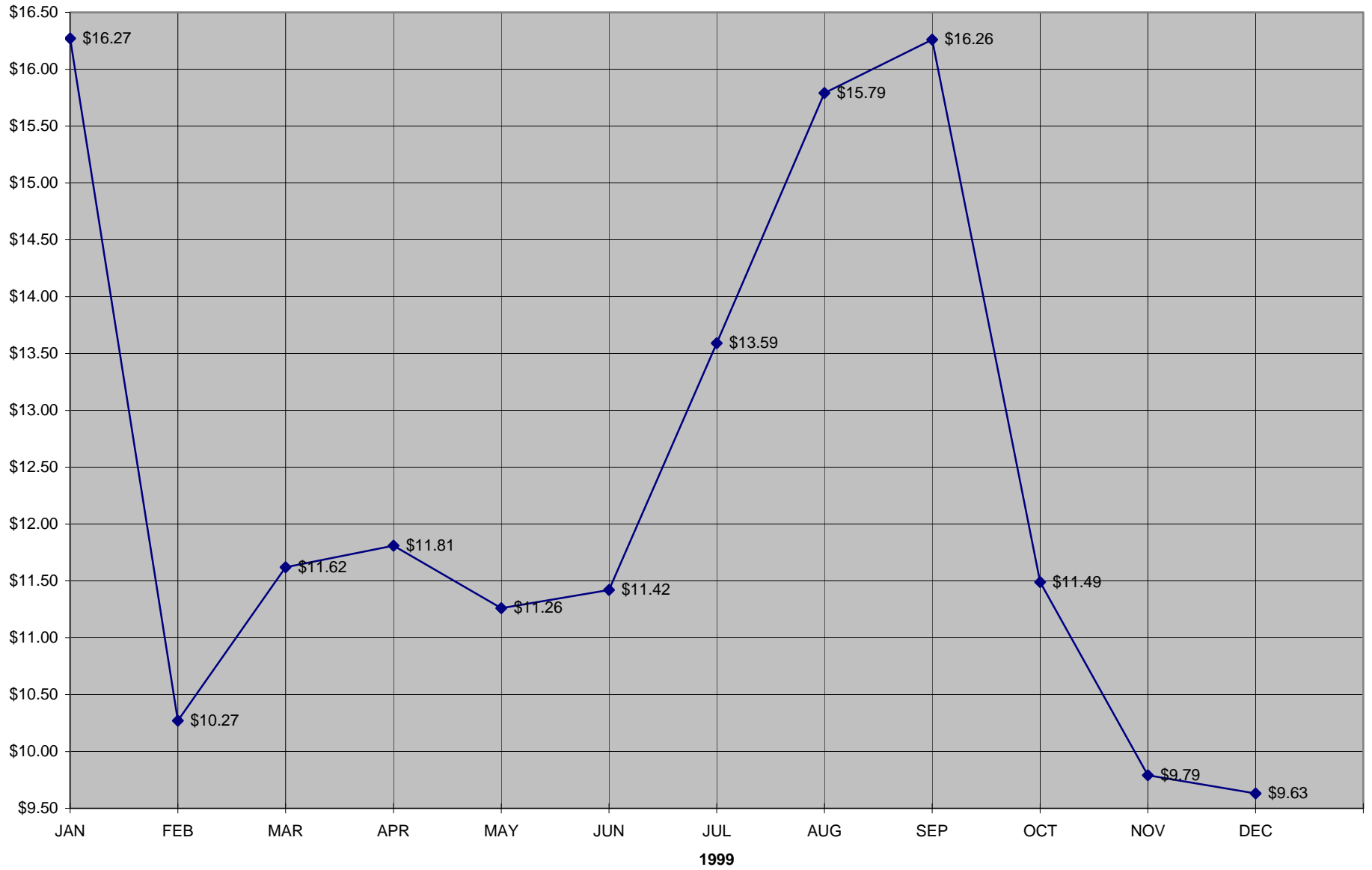


Chart 2 - Federal Order Price Comparisons

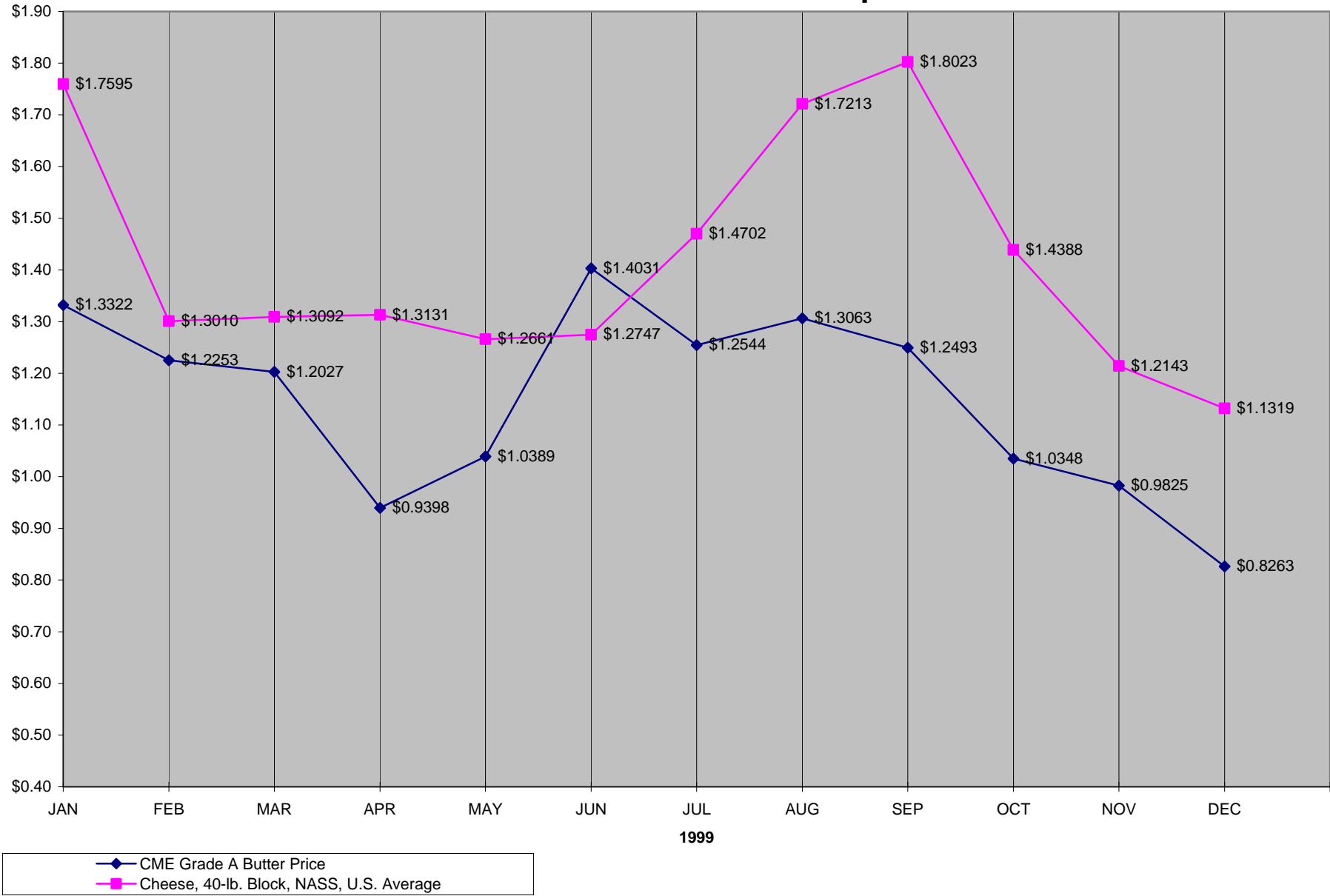


Chart 3 - Uniform Price Comparison
