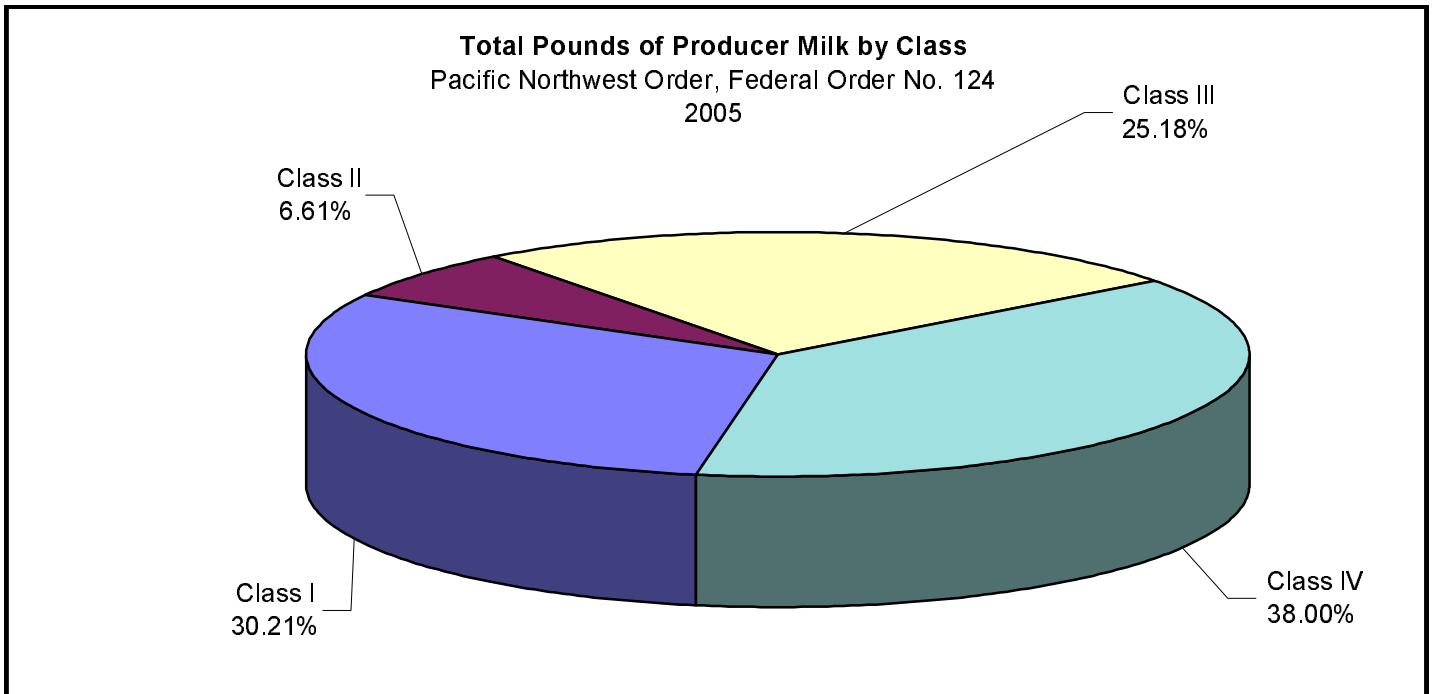

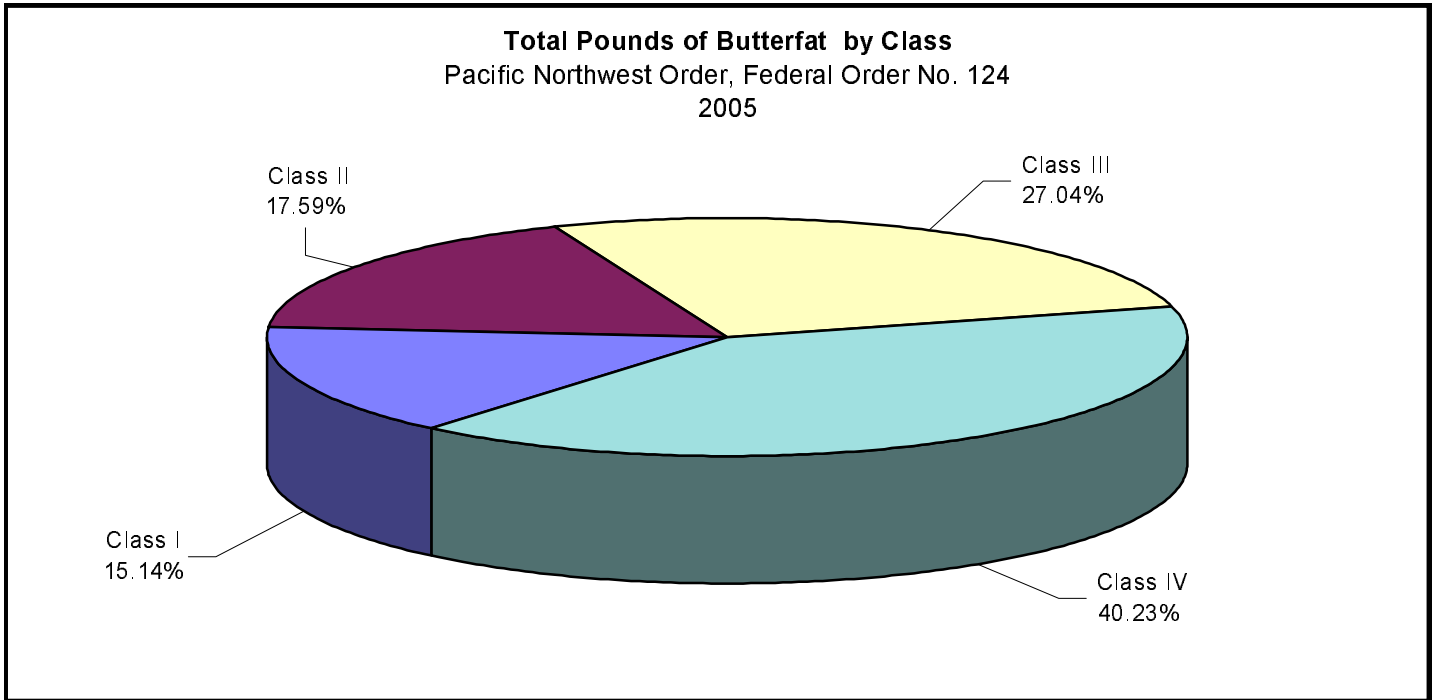

Pacific Northwest Order, Federal Order No. 124 - May 2005

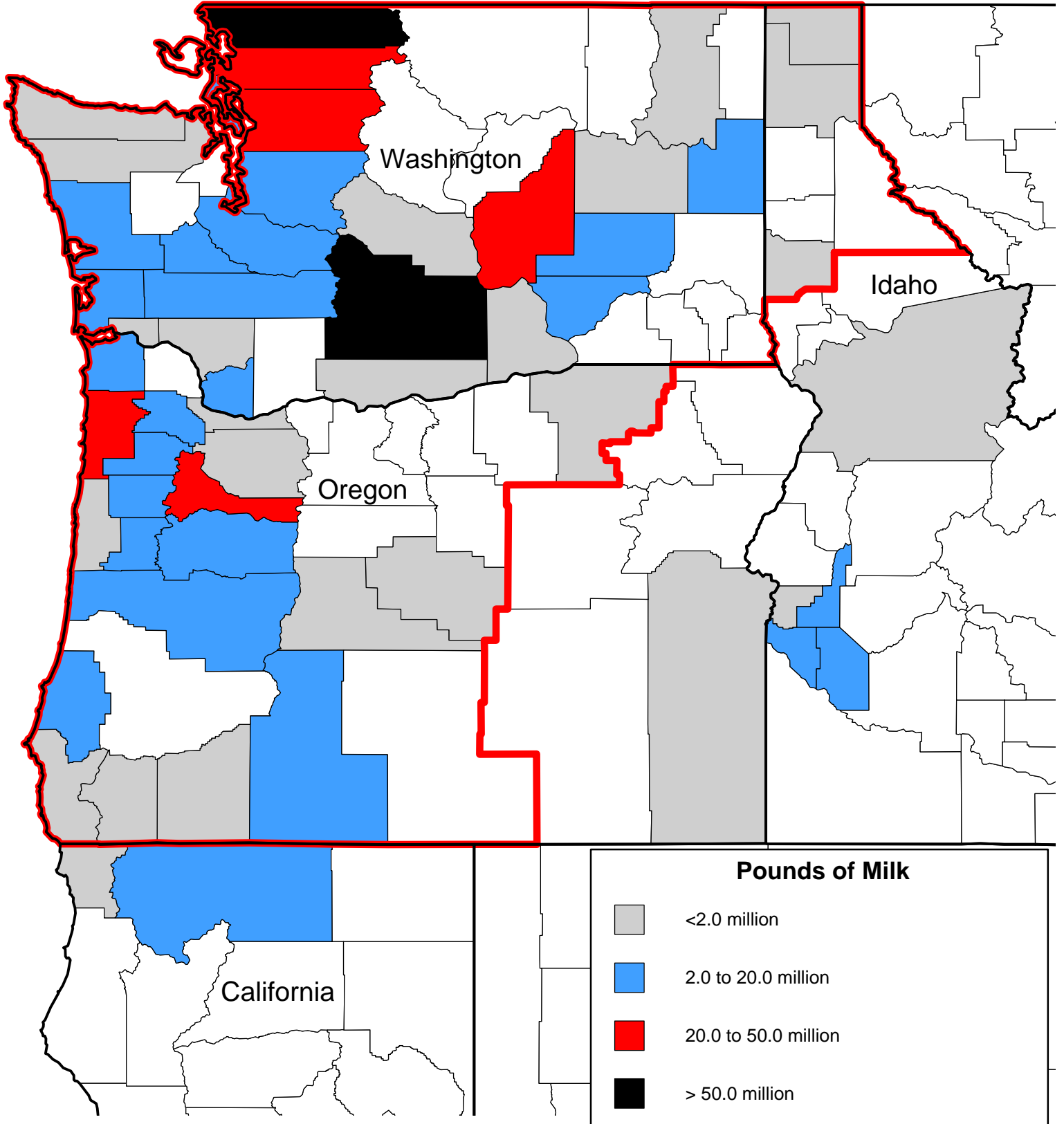
