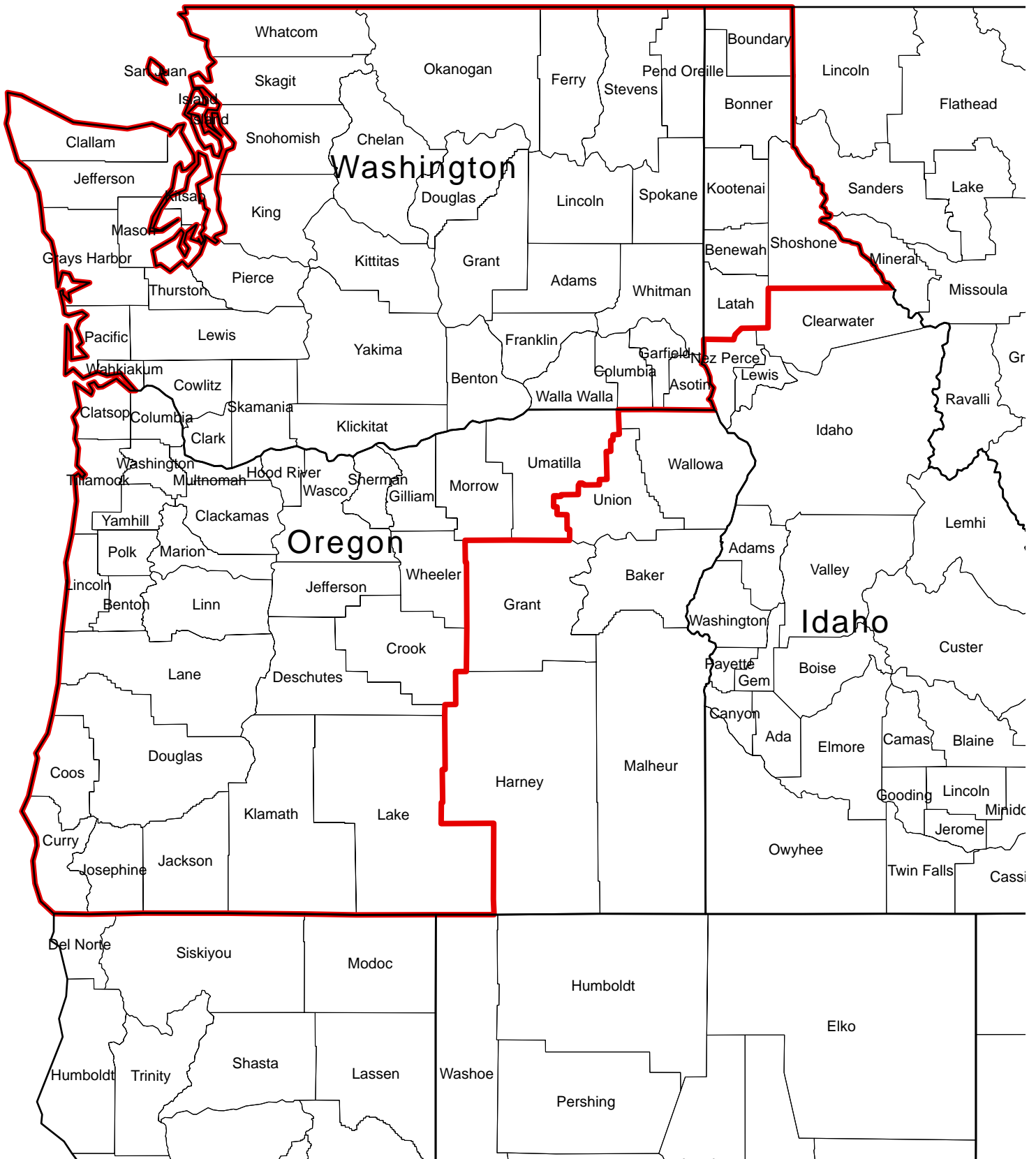

## County Names

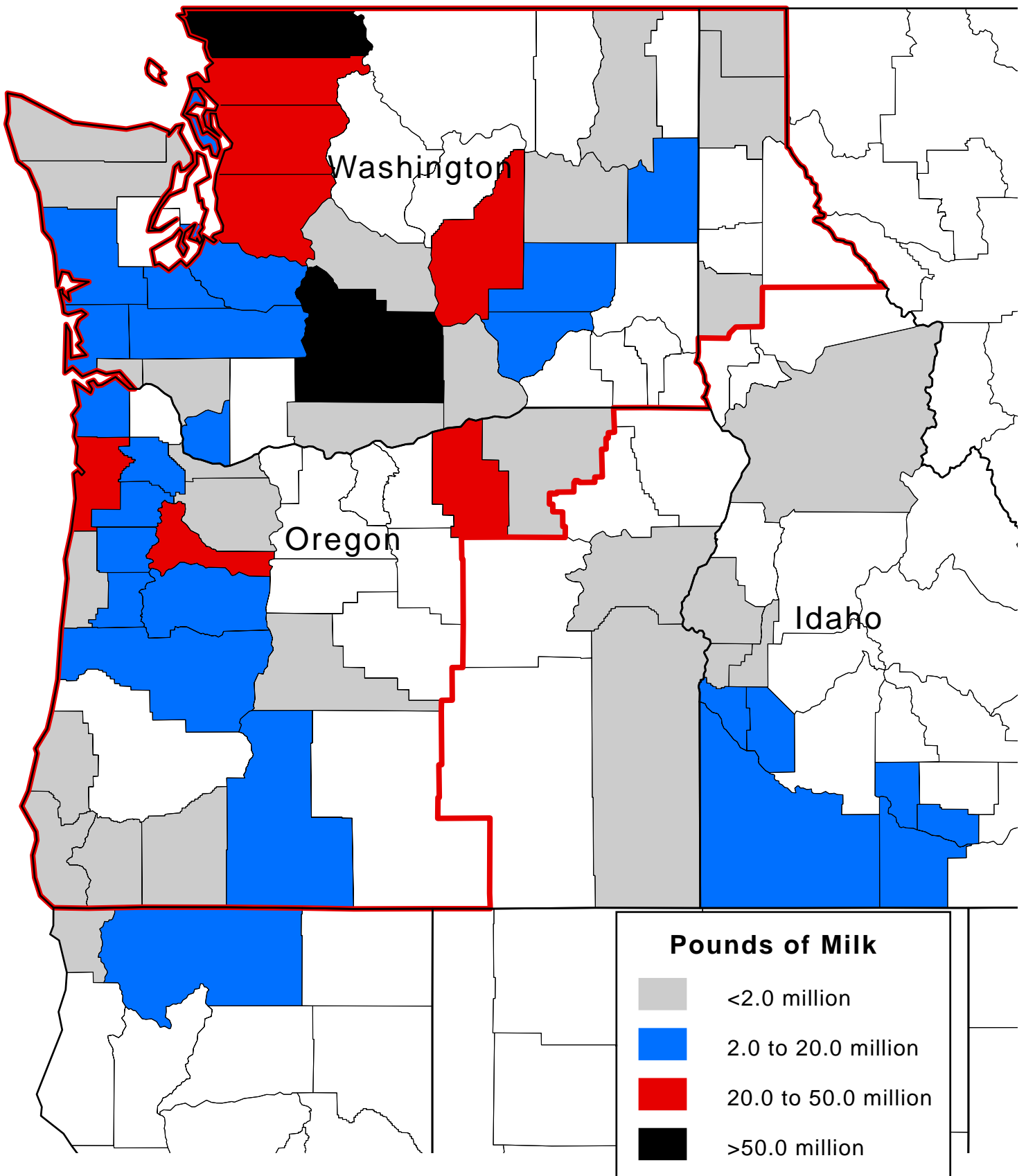

## Producer Milk By County

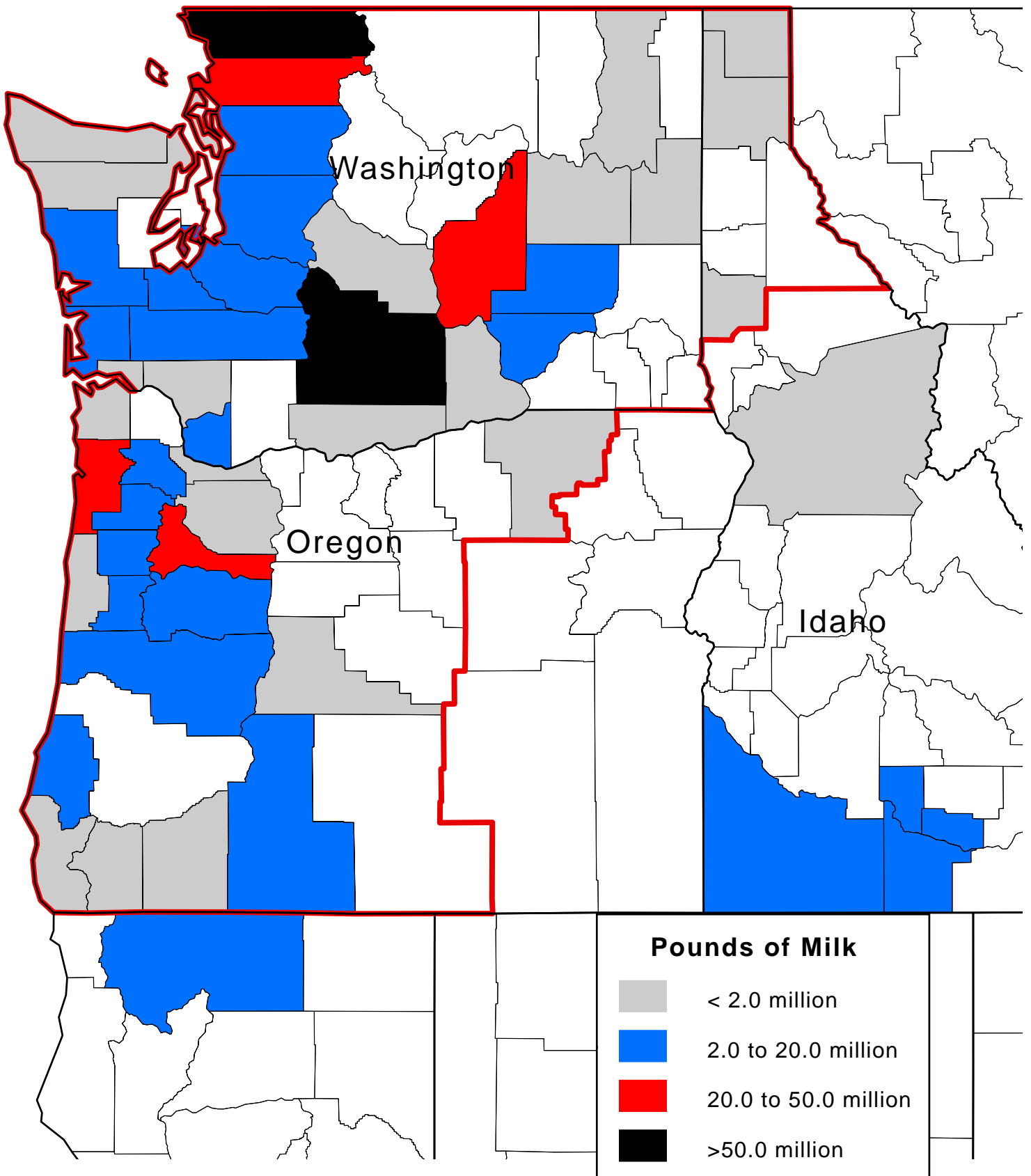

Pacific Northwest Order, Federal Order No. 124 - November 2006

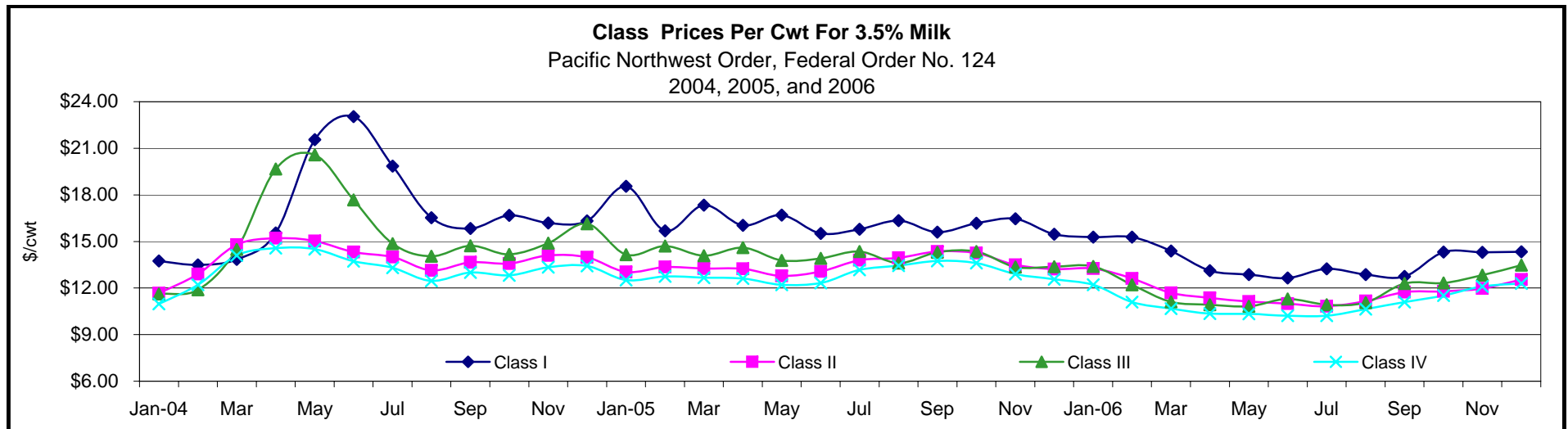
