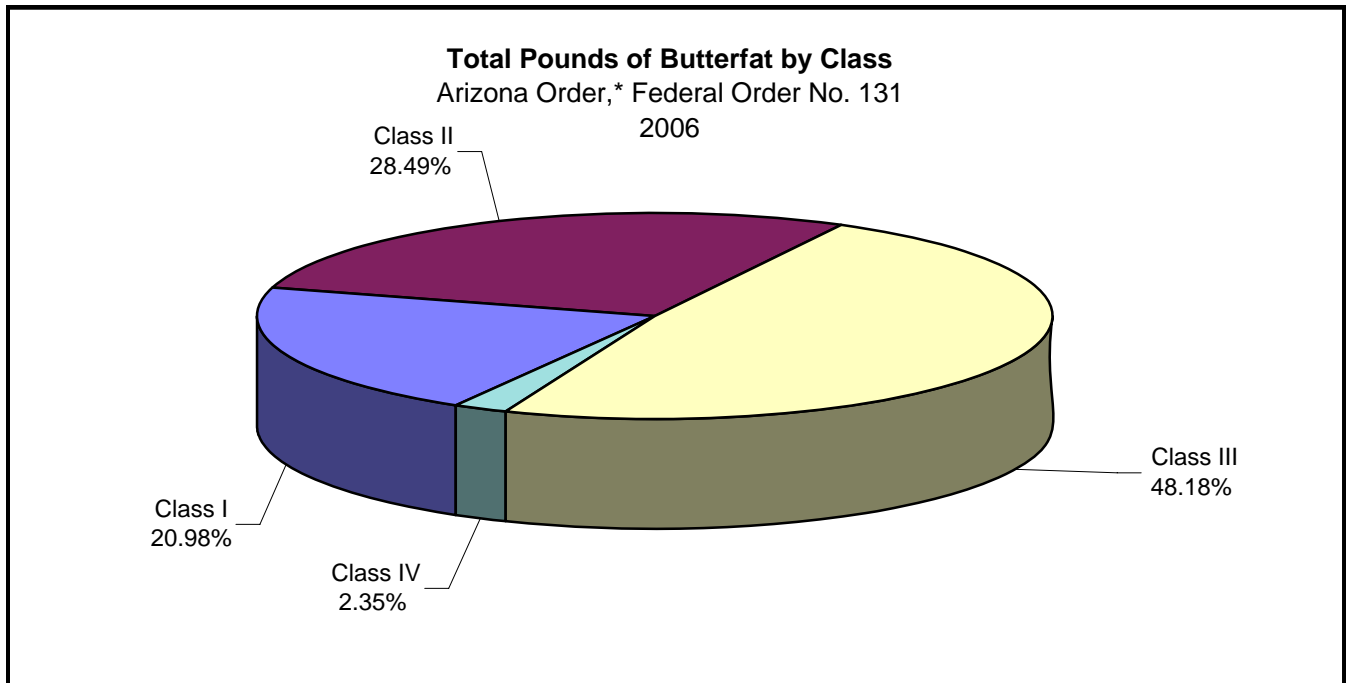

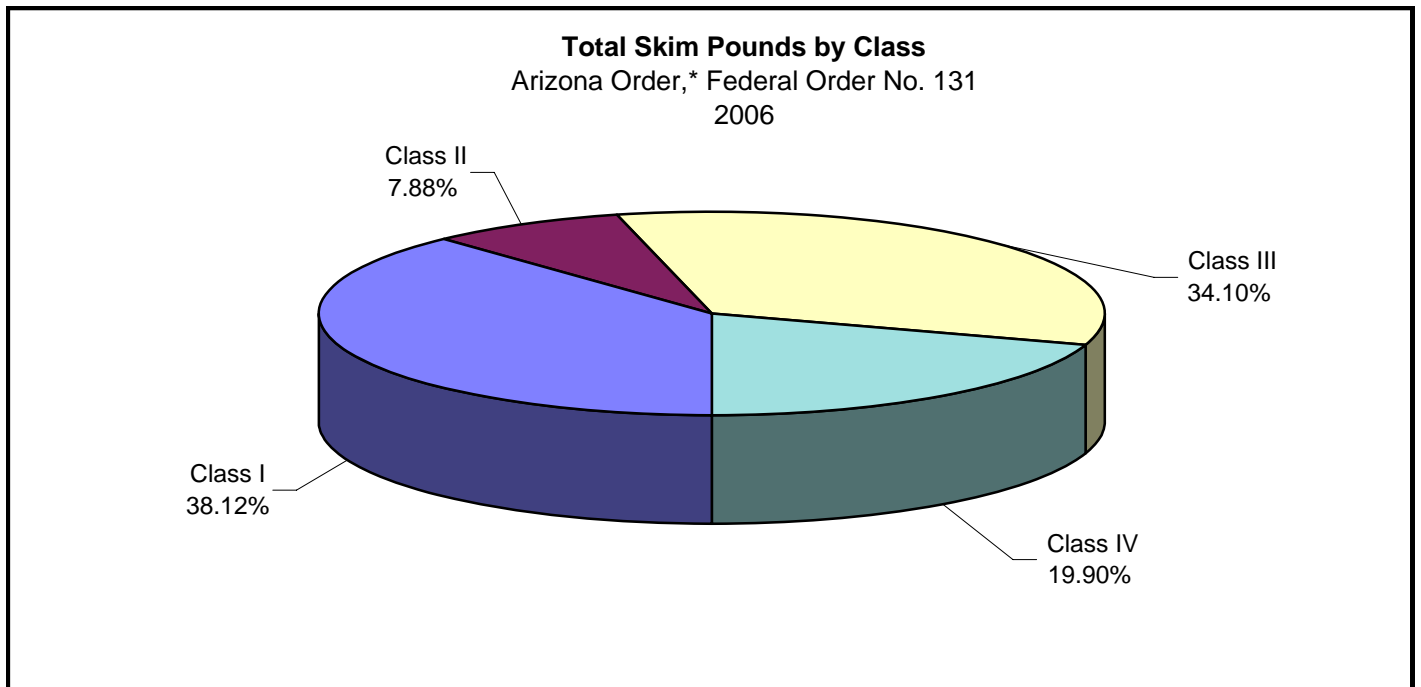

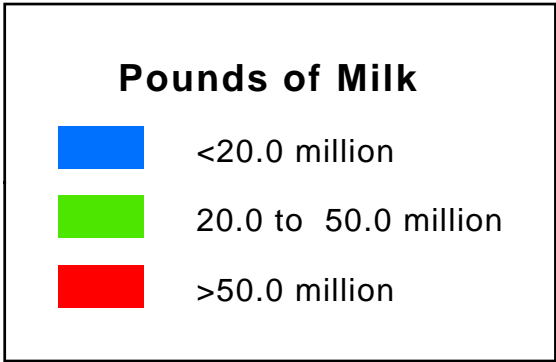
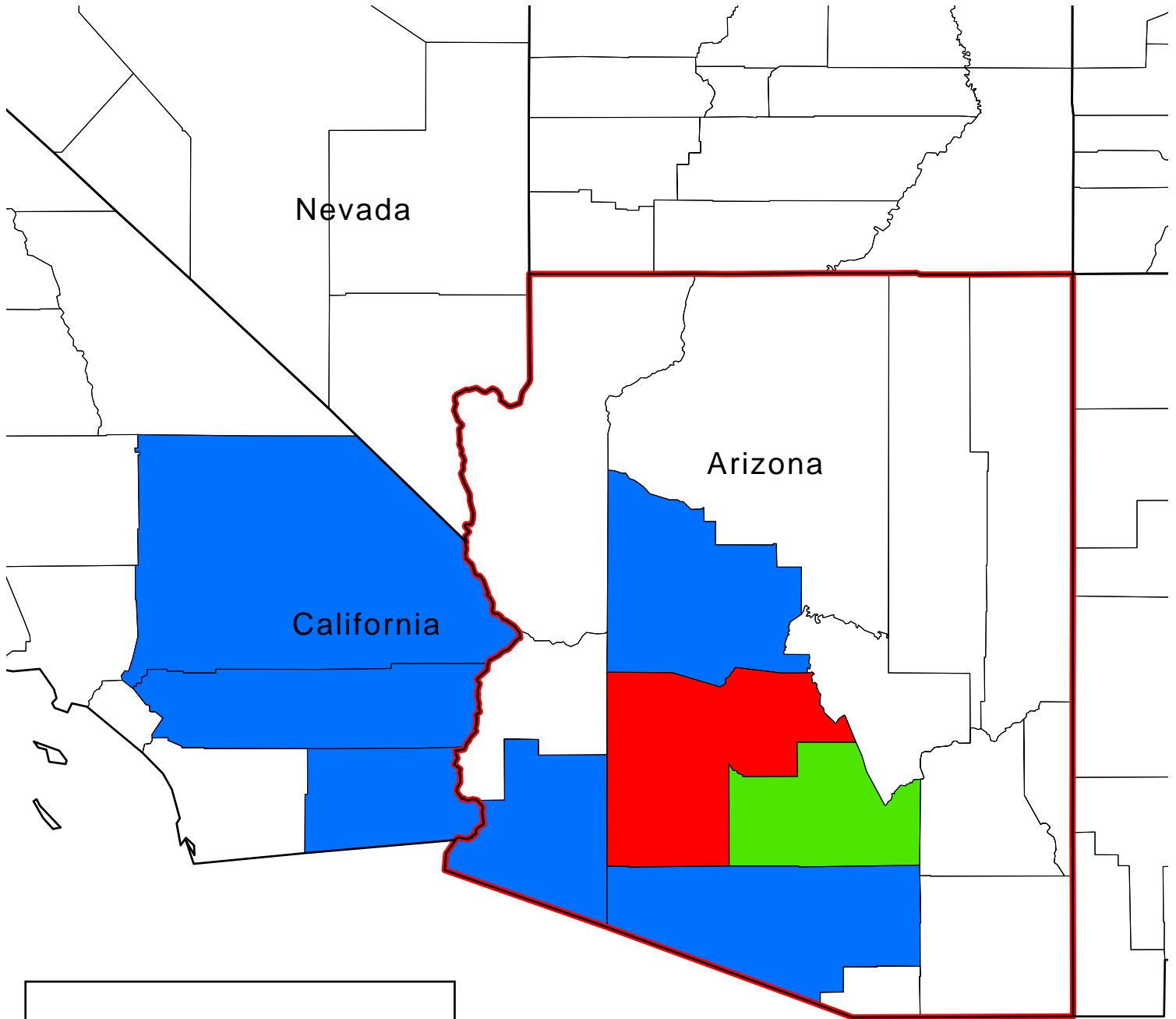

Arizona Order, Federal Order No. 131 - November 2006

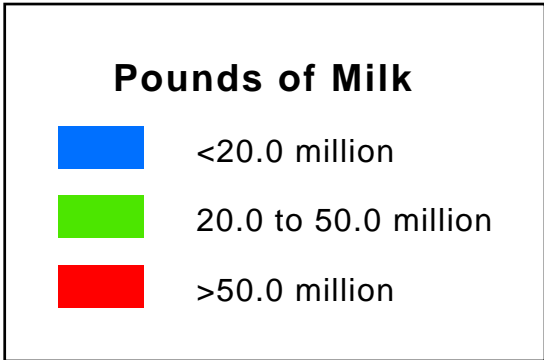
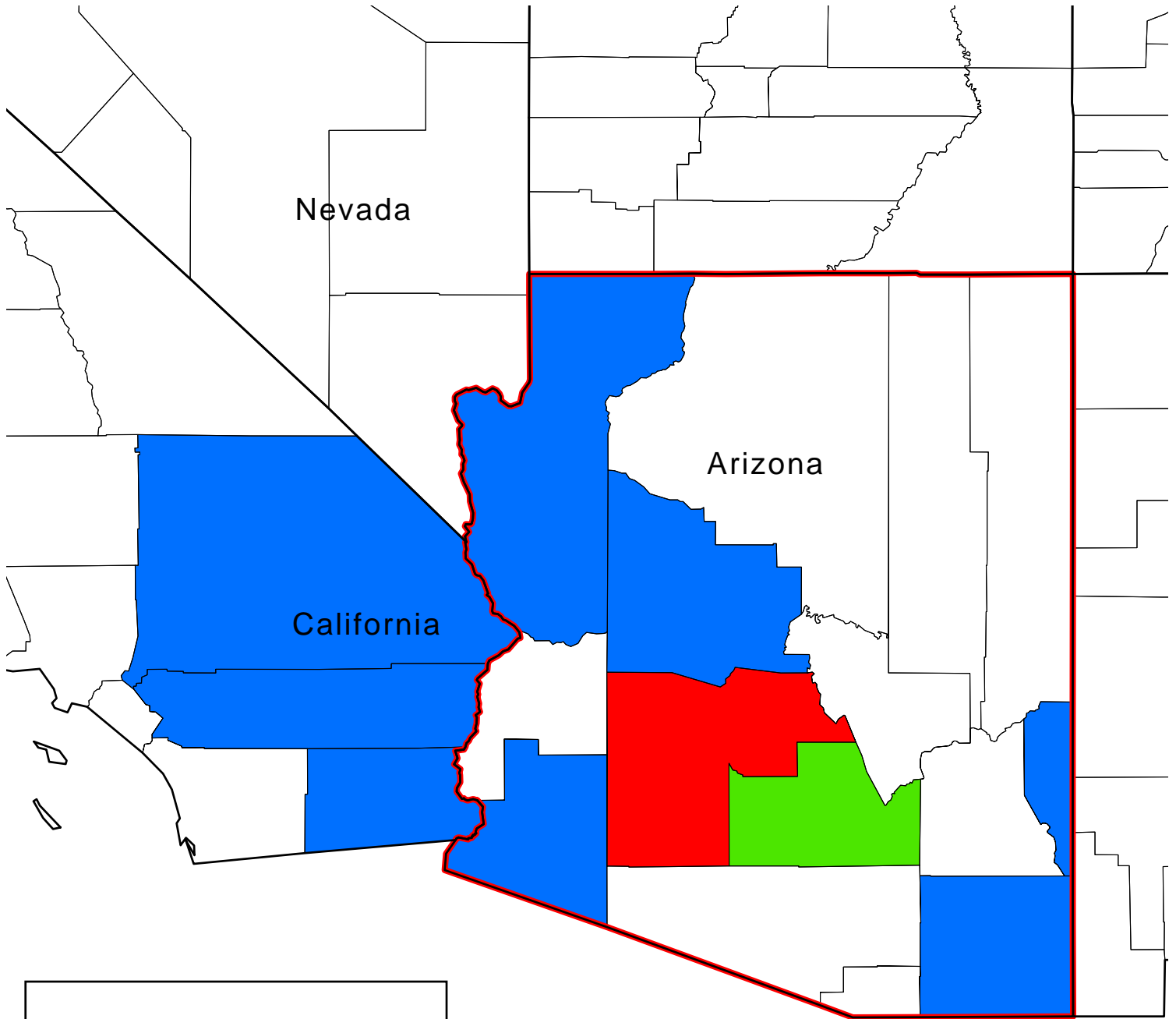
